Here we are at the beginning of a new deer season. Deer Hunting Season in California gives bowhunters an added advantage. Archery only season precedes the regular rifle season! Archery season is open in certain zones already! So are you ready? Need your license? They are available for \$45.93 for most and a deer tag is an extra \$30.50. Need hunter education class? Try [www.theclarkranch.com](http://www.theclarkranch.com) and checkout the evening classes offered at United Sportsmen in Concord starting September 3, 4, 5, 10 and 11th from 6:30-9:30. This is the minimum requirement to obtain your license for deer hunting along with valid ID of course! Interested in having a bowhunter education class? Visit our fellow archers August 17 at 8am at San Francisco Archers in Pacifica. They are hosting an all day bowhunter education class for a \$5.00 fee. This class is not required to hunt with a bow in California but is required in other states.

So now your legal and ready to go? Have you planned your trip? How long are you going, where are you going, how are you staying? Tent Camping on your own or a guided adventure with lodge camping, you decide but remember to do your homework, study the areas you plan to hunt and always have a game plan including where you are going to have your meat processed because of course...your going to catch your game! So if your ready for the time of your life, get ready to deer hunt!

Remember to send me pictures with details of your trip to enter our annual big buck tournament.
