## Range Report

**CAUTION:** The fire hazard will be high to extreme at our range for the next 5 months, please be aware of this and do not use any open flame or charcoal. We can cook on the gas BBQ. If you are working with tools, be aware that they can cause a spark and ignite a fire. Smoke only on gravel near club house.

The steps on the Dixon round between T 23 and 24 have been completed by Brian Slettengren and helpers, thank you Brian for completing this awesome upgrade to our range! Shoot the Dixon and check out the stairs. See photos.

Target 20 on the Dixon round and Target 40 on the Jones round have been raised up so all shooters can see the entire target.

The back of the scoreboard has been painted and work has started painting the benches on the rounds. The picket fence near the out houses will be getting painted.

We have secured enough rubber to finish covering the top, side and bottom of any target butts that are not properly protected. We will start this project at the July work party.

When we replace targets at the work parties, the old targets should be placed near the trailer at T 43. The old targets will be taken to a recycle center.

Work has been done at the Brewer shack to bring it back into service for selling food at the shoots we host.
