Poison oak was sprayed throughout the Regalia and Dixon round.

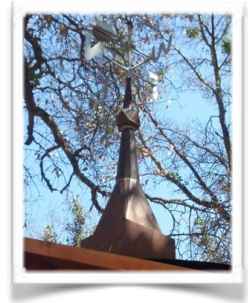
